## **PETITION**

## To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales.

This petition of certain citizens of New South Wales brings to the attention of the House the exorbitant cost of basic water infrastructure in the Upper Hunter Shire Council area that is being forced on ratepayers. Access to fresh water is an essential service, and water rates for the Upper Hunter Shire Council area are disproportionately high when compared to residents in Sydney.
